



EFCE Lifetime Achievement Award

The Lifetime Achievement Award of the European Federation of Chemical Engineering (EFCE) is given to an individual in recognition of his/her sustained and outstanding contribution to the progress of chemical engineering in general and on specific topics covered by the EFCE Working Parties and Sections in particular, over a period of at least 20 years. The award acknowledges the candidates substantial dedication to raising the profile of the field of Chemical Engineering and the EFCE through research and teaching, the organisation of conferences and workshops, and commitment to the WPs and/or Sections of the EFCE.

Selection procedure

The award is given at ECCE events. No calls for the award are made. The President of the EFCE receives nominations from at least three member societies, WPs and/or Sections. Based on the nominations received, the President prepares a proposal for approval by the Executive Board.

Frequency

There is no fixed frequency but the award will only be given at ECCE events.

Award details

The award includes a certificate, a silver medal (sponsored by the Hungarian Society for the first five medals), free registration at the ECCE-event where the award will be given.
