Molzahn awarded EFCE Dieter Behrens medal

Dr. Martin Molzahn of Germany has been awarded the highly coveted Dieter Behrens Medal by the EFCE. Comprising of a certificate, plaque and travel grant the medal will be presented during the festive congress opening of ECCE 7 and CHISA 2010 in Prague, Czech Republic on 28 August 2010.
